PRE-BEGINNERS: To compete in Pre-Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a First Prize in either Pre-Beginners or Beginners nor gained a third place or above in any other obedience class.
BEGINNERS: To compete in Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a total of two or more First Prizes in Beginners Class, or one First Prize in any other Obedience Class. (Pre-Beginners excepted).

NOVICE: For dogs which have not won two First Prizes in Obedience Classes. (Pre-Beginners and Beginners excepted).

CLASS A: For dogs which have not won three First Prizes in Class A, B and Open Class C in total.

CLASS B: For dogs which have not won three first prizes in Class B and Open Class C in total.

OPEN CLASS C: At Open Shows, and in the Open C Classes held at Championship Shows, open to all dogs.

CHAMPIONSHIP CLASS C: For Championship Class C at Championship Shows, dogs must have won out of Novice, Class A and Class B and have won Open Class C on one occasion and have been placed not lower than third on three occasions, all Open Class C places and wins under different Judges at Kennel Club licensed shows.

DIRECTIONS TO VENUE

FROM M25: Leave M25 at junction 6 and take A22 north to Caterham/Croydon. In 2 miles, go straight ahead at the major roundabout. In 1 mile turn right at smaller roundabout onto B270 to Warlingham. After 500 yards, turn left up Tithe Pit Shaw Lane signed to Sanderstead and Croydon. In 1 Mile turn right at T junction onto B269. Trenham Drive is on your left in about 300 yards

FROM OTHER DIRECTIONS: The venue is on B269 between Hamsey Green and Warlingham – about 300 yards from the former. The B269 runs from the Red Deer Pub on the A235 which is the main north-south road from Croydon to Purley

RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations are to be read in conjunction with The Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations, available from the Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of judging (10.00am) after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
3. Prize money is not on offer.
4. The Society's policy on refunds to competitors in the event of cancellation of the show is to refund entry fees deducting the fixed and irrecoverable costs incurred by the show
5. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.

6. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete Number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.

7. ANIMALS ALLOWED IN EVENT

No animal other than one officially entered shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee. However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times.

8. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for competition at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows.

9. A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the Show if it is:-
a. A bitch which is in season.

b. Suffering from any infectious or contagious disease.

c. Interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent.

d. Of such temperament or is so much out of hand as to be a danger to the safety of any person or other animal.

e. Likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.

10. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show.

11. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.

12. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the Judge or Judges.

13. Should circumstances so dictate the Society, in consultation with the judges, may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.

14. The show is sponsored by Genesis Pet Foods and Petneeds.

15. Not applicable to this show.

16. The use of cooking stoves in the proximity of tenting and benching areas is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.

17. No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine Press wherever possible.

18. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged four calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their full details recorded on the entry form.

19. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.

20. **WELFARE OF DOGS.** An exhibitor (or competitor) whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.

DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

1. In the following Definitions of Classes First Prize wins in Limited Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Show Obedience Classes but do count for eligibility at Limited Obedience Shows or Open Shows confined to one breed.
2. A dog not qualified to enter Championship Class C must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another standard class if desired plus one additional special class if scheduled. Only qualified dogs may be entered in Championship Class C and these dogs may also enter Open Class C and/or one additional class if scheduled. (Note the qualification for Championship Class C and Obedience Warrant.) Exemptions from this regulation are:- A dog entered in a Good Citizen Dog Scheme Special Pre-Beginner Obedience Stakes Class or a Young Kennel Club (YKC) Obedience Class which may also be entered in a maximum of two other scheduled classes (including YKC classes) for which it is eligible

If an error is made the dog may be disqualified by the committee of the Kennel Club in the name of the exhibitor. If the register or transfer or ownership has not been confirmed it must be applied for before the closing date of entries. In case of dispute proof of postage of such applications may be required by The Kennel Club. Puppies under six months of age on the first day of the show cannot be entered for competition. On no account will entries be accepted without fees. If a dog is in the process of registration or transfer at the time entry is made, add the letters NAF or TAF as appropriate after its name. Please put classes in numerical order and use BLOCK LETTERS throughout completing this entry form. **PLEASE CHECK ALL DETAILS BEFORE POSTING.**

* The Kennel Club Registration Number (or Authority to compete number for dogs resident outside the UK) must be stated or the entry will be returned.
